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Your Tree Board has put together a list of tree planting recommendations to assist you in your planting endeavors. The following list was prepared by our Urban Forester, Wedi VanBuren.

SHADE TREES – These trees should not be planted close to the sidewalk because their large roots will damage the sidewalks.



-  Thornless Honey Locust
-  Tulip Poplar
-  Oak Red or White
-  Linden Tree

Do not plant trees above the graft bump. (The bump on the tree, near base)

MID-SIZE TREE – 25 to 30 foot in size

-  Washington Hawthorn
-  Downey Service Berry
-  Red Bud
-  Dogwood

LANDSCAPE SHRUBS – Flowering and privacy

-  Rose of Sharon
-  Crepe Myrtle

GROUND COVER

-  Cotton Easter
