Position: Part Time Summer Maintenance Worker I

Job Responsibilities: The primary responsibilities will be mowing, weed-eating and litter control; repair and flushing of fire hydrants, street cleaning when necessary; repair of potholes; maintain public buildings; maintenance of village vehicles; landscaping; and other duties deemed necessary by the Village Administrator. Typical work week is 7:30 am to 4:00 pm, 5 days per week from May through August. There may be times when a non-standard work week with an on-call roll is necessary such as a snow emergency, but the typical work week is dayshift hours.

Minimum Qualifications: Must possess a high school diploma or GED or any combination of education, training and/or experience.

Personal Requirements: Physically fit and able to lift up to 50 lbs., capable of working alone methodically and accurately, self-motivated and disciplined, self-starter, good driving record, good communication skills with the public and co-workers. Must be able to pass a pre-employment drug and alcohol test. Position is subject to random drug and alcohol testing.

Pay Range: Maintenance Worker I Position, part time for the summer – Pay \$ 18.00 per hour
