Call to Order

Purpose

The Mayor stated the purpose for the meeting: Flock Cameras.

Mayor Fisher discussed the cost, value and whether or not to keep the flock cameras currently in the Village. Council voted to have the flock cameras installed therefore council will have to vote on any changes to them. The mayor informed council that only a couple of notifications by the flock cameras have occurred and he does not feel that the cost of \$3,000 per camera per year justifies keeping the cameras. Chief Kilburn agreed and informed council that the police department is looking into Axon for a possible replacement that would not cost nearly as much.

Discussion followed and council agreed that if the police department does not see the need then removing the cameras and ending the agreement will need to take place.

Motion by Frederick to suspend the rules and waive three readings of Resolution #13-26; second by Pitzer. Motion by Frederick to adopt Resolution #13-26, approving the removal and cancellation of Flock cameras in the Village; second by Hardin. All yea. Motion carried.
